HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR OCT. 1, 2023-SEPT. 30, 2024

- Produced the Northwest Dispute Resolution Conference in March after a 5-year hiatus due to the pandemic. Keynote speakers included Dr. Chantal Prat, neuroscientist at the University of Washington, and Nina Meierding, an accomplished and nationally recognized local mediation professional.
- Established the Alan Kirtley Dispute Resolution Conference Scholarship to advance the practice of dispute resolution and appreciate and recognize Professor Kirtley's many contributions, including education, training, legislation (RCW Chapter 7.07), DR Advocacy, and scholarly contributions at the local, state, and national levels.
- In April, produced a Mini-CLE discussing early dispute resolution for members of HOAs and attended by 582 individuals.
- Recruited 2 newly licensed lawyers to join the Executive Committee, to help begin offering more benefits for younger professionals.
