HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

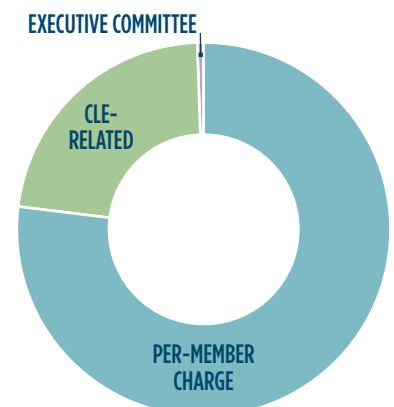
- The Collaboration Committee participated in Section Leader meetings as a collaboration pathway.
