HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

OCT. 1, 2024 - SEPT. 30, 2025

- Held the 37th Annual Indian Law CLE in partnership with the Tulalip Tribes of Washington and Stokes Lawrence LLP—the first time the CLE was held outside of Seattle and in partnership with a local Native Nation.
- Provided financial assistance to the Native American Law Student Association (NALSA) groups at Seattle Univ. School of Law, UW School of Law, Gonzaga School of Law, the Northwest Indian College, and to the SU and UW scholarship funds. Funds were utilized for attendance at moot court competitions and scholarships for members.
- Sponsored a table at the UW NALSA Salmon Bingo Dinner and the UW Law annual symposium.

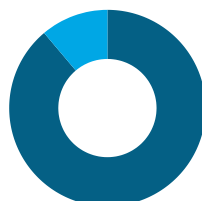
