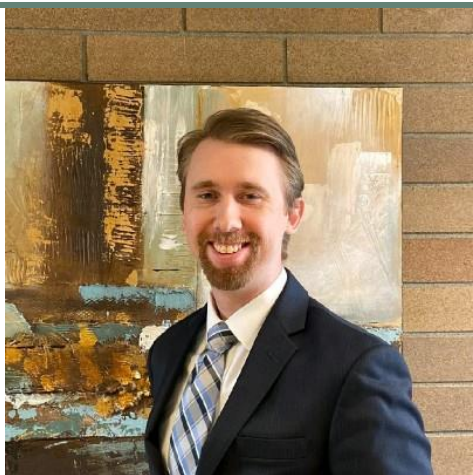


Michael Austin Harris
