- Cap gains bill:
 - Shifts rules of statutory construction; ambiguity rule in favor of taxing authority (not taxpayer); fundamental fairness issue that taxpayer should understand obligations and legislation should clearly spell out those obligations
 - GR12 standard as impact to administration of justice
 - Yes we should comment on this bill; should also consider long-term education for legislature regarding fundamental fairness requirements
 - Discussion occurred regarding motion to send letter to state (constitutional issues, administration of justice; unintended litigation consequences, general fairness); Motion made to approve preparing and sending letter to WA regarding fundamental unfairness of ambiguity favoring State in tax law; second made; approved
